




A Typical Kingdom PLAY Time Schedule

- Length:** Typically 20-30 minutes a session. Each lesson taught weekly for a month.
- Help:** One Kingdom PLAY facilitator. In addition to the facilitator, for infants, 1 caregiver to every 1-2 kids. For toddlers, 1 caregiver to every 3-5 kids. This allows enough interaction and care for each kid to participate and play.
- Props:** One set for the facilitator to use for demonstration. Ideally, a set of toys for each smaller group. Definitely enough toys for all children to have the opportunity to get their hands on the props, participate and play.
- PLAY area:** An open floor space with enough room for kids to move around and play with the toys.

A Typical Kingdom PLAY Time Routine

Kingdom PLAY is designed to create a space and content for kids to learn about God and His love through PLAY. Each children's ministry, class, school, group, or family is different and will have different needs. There is definitely room to be flexible and to adapt the curriculum to the needs and wants of your specific group.

Each Kingdom PLAY Time includes:

- **Main teaching point and Bible verse**
- **Signs** - suggested signs to use and a still photo to help.
- **Props** - suggested props/toys to use. There is room for flexibility here.
- **Kingdom PLAY Welcome Time** - a consistent way to begin Kingdom PLAY.
- **Singing Time** - a time and space for you to greet kids with a name song and praise.
- **Bible Time** - a time to read the story from your fave children's Bible. Hands-on, play activities to support key points of the lesson with language and concept-rich content.
- **Prayer Time** - a consistent framework for kids to learn to talk with God.
- **Celebration Time** - a time to bust out the play instruments and PRAISE THE LORD with your favorite worship songs.
